

The following participating individuals are required to attend a formal training session:

- New Point Persons: required
- Returning Point Persons: required
- New Lake Host employees: required
- New volunteer Lake Hosts: optional, *but recommended*
- Returning volunteer and Lake Host employees: optional, *but recommended*

Registration:

- Register for training sessions **ON-LINE** at www.nhlakes.org/lake-host at least one week before a scheduled training session and provide names, positions, and contact information for the individuals who will be attending the formal training.

The following participants are required to attend a local training given by the Point Person/Managing Lake Host:

- Returning Lake Host employees that do not attend a 2016 formal training session.
- Returning volunteer Lake Hosts that do not attend a 2016 formal training session.
- New volunteer Lake Hosts that do not attend a 2016 formal training session.

 - TUESDAY, May 24, 6:00 – 8:00 p.m., NH DES, 29 Hazen Drive, Concord, NH
 - TUESDAY, June 7, 6:00 – 8:00 p.m., NH DES, 29 Hazen Drive, Concord, NH.
 - SATURDAY, June 25, 9:00 – 12:00 noon, NH DES, 29 Hazen Drive, Concord, NH (*This training includes species identification session and Lake Host/Boater interaction role play with boat and trailer.*)

Formal Training Session Registration REMINDERS:

- Please plan to arrive **at least 10 minutes** before the start of the session.
- **Lake Host employees:** Please bring your employment papers and appropriate forms of identification to the training session if you have not already completed your hiring paperwork with your Point Person.
- **Lake Host Point Persons:** Please know how many shirts, hats, decals, totes, clip boards, brochures, manuals, and specimen bags you will need to pick up at the training.

Driving directions to NH Department of Environmental Services, 29 Hazen Drive, Concord, NH:

- **From the South and West:**
 - Take I-93 north to Exit 14, turn right at intersection.
 - At third light (at top of hill), turn left onto Hazen Drive.
 - Turn left at sign for Health & Human Services.
 - Visitor parking is available in front of building. Enter at the main entrance by the flag pole.
- **From the North:**
 - Take I-93 south to Exit 15E onto I-393.
 - Take Exit 2 and turn left at end of exit ramp (East Side Drive).
 - Stay to the right and turn right at light onto Hazen Drive.
 - Turn right at sign for Health & Human Services.
 - Visitor parking is available in front of building. Enter at the main entrance by the flag pole.
- **From the East:**
 - Take Route 4 west to Concord. (Route 4 becomes I-393 in Concord.)
 - Take Exit 2 and turn left at end of exit ramp.
 - Stay to the right and turn right at second light onto Hazen Drive.
 - Turn right at sign for Health & Human Services.
 - Visitor parking is available in front of building.
 - Enter at the main entrance by the flag pole.

Driving directions to Squam Lakes Association, 534 US Route 3, Holderness, NH:

- **From the North and South and West:**
 - Take I-93 to Exit 24.
 - Merge onto Main Street/US Route 3 South/NH Route 25 South toward Ashland/Holderness/Squam Lakes.
 - Turn slight left onto Route 3 South/Route 25/Main Street. Continue to follow Route 3/Route 25.
 - Approximately 0.1 miles past Grapevine Cove Road, 534 Route 3 (Squam Lakes Association) will be on the left. *(If you reach Shepard Hill Road, you have gone about 0.2 miles too far.)*
- **From the East:**
 - Take NH Route 25/Route 25B towards Holderness.
 - Turn right onto US Route 3/Route 25.
 - Approximately 0.2 miles past Crowell Point Road, 534 Route 3 (Squam Lakes Association) will be on the right. *(If you reach Martson Road, you have gone a little too far.)*
